ZOE for Life! is Going Medical!!

In the past we have been able to help mothers and infants by meeting some of their material, and spiritual needs. While this is a very needed and worthwhile service, we recognize the multi-faceted needs of women and men in crisis pregnancy. We desire to assist them even further during this challenging time. Therefore, through the prayerful support of the faithful, ZOE for Life! is taking another step toward abundant life and, in faith, is beginning the process of adding peer counseling and limited medical services!

The first step in this journey has already begun, as we continue to search for a larger, more suitable space for this pan-orthodox ministry. Additionally, we have volunteer training scheduled for Saturday, November 24, 2015, for any and all who wish to participate. This will focus on basic verbal and nonverbal communication practices utilized in peer counseling situations, as well as practical exercises on introducing one to a relationship with Jesus Christ. (Please let us know if you would like to attend or if you have any questions about this.)

Next we will begin to develop policies and procedures for the medical component. This will consist of pregnancy testing and limited obstetrical ultrasound to confirm the viability of a pregnancy. Statistics tell us that as high as 90% of abortion-minded or abortion-vulnerable women who see an ultrasound of their babies choose not to abort. We believe that the impact of this service is just too significant to ignore.

Of course this means we need your support. You have been incredibly generous with your resources. That is what got us to this point. Now, as we move further into our mission statement, we need you even more. Please prayerfully consider donating your resources: time, expertise, finances, and prayers. 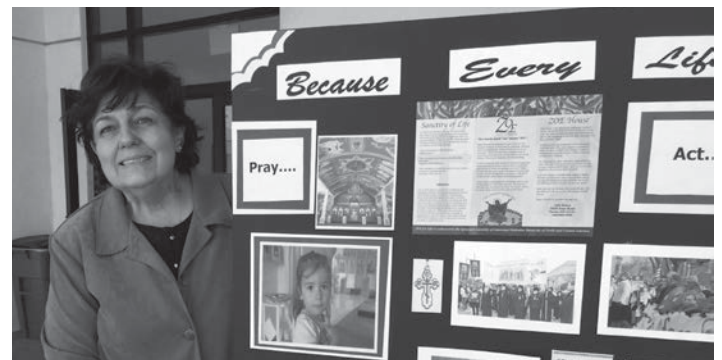
“A Taste of Greece” Greek Festival

As we have received 501c(3) status from the IRS, all donations are tax deductible.

Christian Churches) of Metropolitan Detroit, we will endeavor to increase our outreach and provide spiritual and material assistance to an ever widening circle of clients.
